Infrastructure Work Update – MacKenzie's Brook in Cavendish *Prince Edward Island National Park*

Charlottetown, PEI, January 31, 2020 – Parks Canada would like to inform the public that infrastructure work has concluded for the winter at MacKenzie's Brook in PEI National Park. MacKenzie's Brook passes beneath the Gulf Shore Parkway and the Gulf Shore Way trail between Cavendish and North Rustico.

While work is mostly completed, some shore protection, paving and landscaping will occur in the spring. An update will be shared when this final work is scheduled to begin. The Gulf Shore Parkway West will remain accessible throughout the winter.

This work is part of the largest infrastructure plan in the history of Parks Canada. These investments in Parks Canada's heritage, visitor and waterway infrastructure ensure safe, high quality and meaningful experiences for visitors, enabling Canadians to discover nature and connect with history all across the country.
