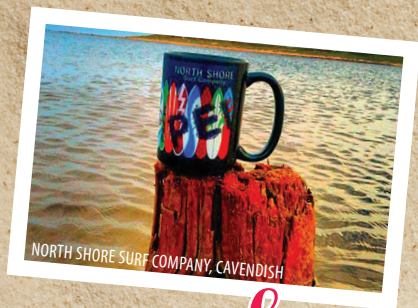

Argyle Shore Provincial Park

Rte. 19. Annandale Wharf Rd. A little red sand beach. Play area, picnic facilities. Unsupervised. Facilities.

Brackley Beach, PEI National Park

Off Rte. 15. White sand beach. Supervised. Facilities.

Cabot Beach Provincial Park

North of Malpeque, off Rte. 20. White and red sand beach. Red cliffs. Play area. Supervised. Facilities.

Cavendish, PEI National Park

Gulf Shore Parkway, Rte. 6. White sand beach. Red cliffs. Supervised. Facilities.

Chelton Beach Provincial Park

Chelton Road, off Rte 10. White sand beach. Play area. Supervised. No facilities.

Dalvey Beach, PEI National Park

Gulf Shore Parkway. White sand beach. Facilities are located at Dalvey Administration.

Inman Memorial Park

Rte. 19. Shelter. Facilities.

North Rustico, PEI National Park

Gulf Shore Parkway, off Rte. 6. White sand beach. Red cliffs. Supervised. Facilities.

Point Deroche (Blooming Point Beach)

Blooming Point Road, off Rte. 2. White sand beach. Unsupervised. No facilities.

Stanhope Beach, PEI National Park

Gulf Shore Parkway. White sand beach. Supervised. Facilities.

Victoria Beach

Rte. 116. Red sand beach. Play area. Unsupervised. Facilities.
